## About MEMBERSHIP



Members are a diverse outgoing community of women committed to education, action, and social interaction. We are connected to national and international organisations which work to foster social and educational development. We use and maintain our elegant heritage clubhouse, Hycroft. Join us. You will find much to enjoy here.

Our Club was founded in 1907 by a group of eight women. In 1962 the Club acquired Hycroft, a magnificent Edwardian mansion, which was restored by members and declared a heritage building by the City of Vancouver in 1974. Our 100<sup>th</sup> anniversary was celebrated and recorded in *Women Lead the Way* which can be purchased in our office. We will celebrate the centenary of Hycroft in 2011 with events for members and the public.

## MEMBER ACTIVITIES

The Club offers a range of activities, programs, and events in addition to Interest Groups which meet regularly. Members are encouraged to participate in the work of the Club or simply enjoy the activities it has to offer. Guests are welcomed at many of our fellowship activities, talks, and programs. Fellowship events, dinners, lunches, and summer barbecues are held regularly year-round.

## INTEREST GROUPS

There are over 20 interest groups including Bridge, Fitness, Busy Gourmet, Play Reading, Tai Chi, Issues Café, Coach House Painters, Financial Planning and Literacy, Dance, Book Groups, Wine Appreciation, Chick Flicks, Business Networking and more. New groups form as interest groups. Through these groups, members get to know one another and share interests.

## GOVERNANCE AND COMMITTEE WORK

Many members are involved in the work of the Club serving on the board and on committees in the areas of education, status of women and human rights, creative arts, performing arts, social activities and in the work of the CFUW and IFUW. Other committees work on fundraising for scholarships, bursaries, and the maintenance and ongoing stewardship of the property. General meetings, held regularly, provide members with the opportunity to set club policy. The Board of Directors is elected at Annual General Meetings. Copies of the Constitution & Bylaws, Rules, and Procedures are available to all members.

## PROGRAMS AND EVENTS

A wide variety of programs is scheduled throughout the year. Our recitals and art lectures have a loyal following of members and guests. Speakers are regularly invited to present local, national and international issues.

Club members look forward to many annual events including Fashion Show Luncheons in the spring, Annual Dinner in May, annual fundraiser, Christmas at Hycroft, in November preceded by the Christmas at Hycroft Gala, Hycroft Lectures, Members' Barbecue and more.

## SERVING OUR COMMUNITY

Members work on committees in support of the goals of the Club and its national and international counterparts, education of women and girls, advocacy for woman, stewardship of Hycroft and its grounds, scholarships and bursaries, as well as programs and events at Hycroft. Locally we work with other organisations on women's and human rights issues, and present to our local city councillors, MLA's and MP's policies established each year at the annual meetings of our federations. Through the Hycroft Heritage Preservation Foundation we raise funds to support the maintenance of our heritage property. Through the Trust Fund for Education we provide scholarships and bursaries.

## ELIGIBILITY

An Active Member is a woman who holds a degree or the equivalent from an accredited university worldwide. An Associate Member is a woman who shares the values and goals of active membership though she may not have completed a degree. A Student Member is a woman enrolled in full time academic studies towards a degree. A Dual Member belongs to more than one CFUW club.

## ENTRANCE FEE AND ANNUAL DUES

New members pay a one-time entrance fee which is allocated to a special fund for our heritage clubhouse, Hycroft, together with annual dues. Please enquire about current fees, dues, and payment plans.
