MEMBERSHIP

The Club offers a range of daytime and evening activities, programs, and events in addition to interest groups which meet regularly. Members are encouraged to participate in the work of the Club or simply enjoy the activities it has to offer. Guests are welcomed at many of our fellowship activities, talks, programs, events, dinners and lunches held year round.

PROGRAMS AND EVENTS

A wide variety of programs are scheduled on days, evenings and weekends throughout the year. Our recitals and art lectures have a loyal following of members and guests. Speakers are regularly invited to present local, national and international issues and are often paired with social receptions and gourmet meal service.

Club members look forward to many annual events including fashion show luncheons in the spring, annual dinner in spring, Christmas at Hycroft in November, Hycroft Lectures, members' barbecue and more.

INTEREST GROUPS

Self directed groups form regularly around common interests and regularly meet at Hycroft with timing to suit members. Currently there are over 25 interest groups including Bridge, Chick Flicks, Fitness, Busy Gourmet, Hycroft Singers, Play Reading, Tai Chi, Issues Café, Coach House Painters, French Conversation, Financial Planning and Literacy, Dance, Book Groups, Wine Appreciation, Whiskey Women, Networking and more. New groups form as interest grows. Through these groups, members get to know one another, share interests and fun.

GOVERNANCE AND COMMITTEE WORK

Many members are involved in the work of the Club serving on the board and on committees in the areas of education, status of women and human rights, creative arts, performing arts, social activities and in the work of the CFUW and IFUW. Other committees facilitate scholarships, bursaries, and the maintenance and ongoing stewardship of the property. General meetings, held regularly, provide members with the opportunity to set club policy. The Board of Directors is elected at Annual General Meeting. Copies of the Constitution & Bylaws, Rules, and Procedures are available to all members.

SERVING OUR COMMUNITY

Committees function in support of the goals of the Club and its national and international counterparts, education of women and girls, advocacy for the status of woman and human rights, stewardship of Hycroft and its grounds, scholarships and bursaries, as well as programs and events at Hycroft. Locally we work with other organisations on women's and human rights issues, and present to our local city councillors, MLA's and MP's policies established each year at the annual meetings of our federations. Through the Hycroft Heritage Preservation Foundation we raise funds to support the maintenance of our heritage property. Through the Trust Fund for Education we provide scholarships and bursaries.

ELIGIBILITY

An Active Member is a woman who holds a degree or the equivalent from an accredited university worldwide. An Associate Member is a woman who shares the values and goals of active membership though she may not have completed a degree. A Student Member is a woman enrolled in full time academic studies towards a degree. A Dual Member belongs to more than one CFUW club. Other categories include Consular, Temporary and Non-resident.

ENTRANCE FEE AND ANNUAL DUES

New members pay a one-time entrance fee which is allocated to a special fund for our heritage clubhouse, Hycroft, together with annual dues. Please enquire about current fees, dues, and payment plans.
